Dear Partner,

Due to the current coronavirus epidemic, we at Simeon Group have introduced guidelines for staff to prevent coronavirus infection. The guidelines will take effect immediately and are as follows:

- Drivers are not to visit clients' office spaces and control rooms unless it is unavoidable
- Customer visits are minimized in favor of video conferences
- Transport foremen are divided into groups that work separately from each other, in order to reduce transmission risk
- Occasions with over 10 people in attendance will be considered on a case-by-case basis
- Physical contact (e.g. handshaking) is minimized
- The importance of personal hygiene is emphasized, e.g. handwashing and the use of hand disinfectant
- Remote work is enforced for at least 2 weeks following holiday travel
- Visiting work is prohibited for at least 14 days following travel to a high-risk area
- Commuting between offices is minimized and internal meetings are held as video conferences
- Business trips abroad will be considered on a case-by-case basis
- Employees are recommended to avoid large crowds and traveling to high-risk areas in their free time
- Going to work is not allowed if one feels unwell and the guidelines for seeking treatment by occupational health and Finnish Institute of Health and Welfare must be followed
- We are closely following the situation and acting according to the guidelines issued by the authorities.

By enforcing these measures, we want to ensure our operational capability and service level even if the situation worsens.
